# 1. Cultural Discovery

- **Saint-Sernin Basilica**

One of the largest Romanesque basilicas in Europe, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A must-see monument to understand the medieval history of the city.



- **Jacobins Convent**




A masterpiece of Southern Gothic architecture, known for its spectacular stone 'palm tree'. The cloister offers a peaceful setting for a cultural visit.

- **The Capitole**

An iconic building in the city housing the City Hall and the Capitole Theatre. The Hall of Illustrious, inspired by the Hall of Mirrors from the Palace of Versailles is particularly worth a visit.



## 2. Museums




- **Augustins museum**

The Toulouse Museum of Fine Arts, housed in a former convent, offers a Rich collection of sculptures, paintings, and medieval works.

- **Aeroscopia museum**



A museum dedicated to aeronautics where you can board legendary aircrafts such as the Concorde or the A380. Perfect for discovering the aeronautical DNA of Toulouse.

# 3. Walks and Heritage

## ● Garonne river and riverbanks

The riverbanks of the Garonne river offer one of the most beautiful views of the city, particularly of the Dôme de la Grave. Perfect for a stroll at sunset.

**Possible running route** : Garonne Riverbanks → Pont Neuf → Prairie des Filtres.  
An ideal route for participants wishing to maintain their fitness routine during the PGDay.

Start from the Quai de la Daurade - run along the Garonne River to the Pont Neuf - cross the Pont Neuf and continue to the Prairie des Filtres for a pleasant, shaded loop.

\* Option to extend the run to the Saint-Cyprien district or return via the opposite bank for a complete route of approximately 5 to 7 km.

## ● Botanical Garden

The oldest public garden in Toulouse. Ideal for a stroll in a green setting with ponds, sculptures and shaded areas.
